## City Hall, Meetings Open Again



The end of the Statewide Pause means that the City of Boulder City will once again allow limited visitors inside City Hall. City Council, Committee and Commission meetings and workshops will also be open to the public by RSVP only. Public attendance at meetings will again be capped at fifteen people to best maintain social distancing

requirements. Preference will be given to applicants who have an item on the agendas. You may reserve a spot by contacting the City Clerk's office at 702.293.9208. Attendees are required to wear face coverings and may only use designated areas (Council Chambers and the restrooms). Entry will again be allowed in the lobby of the Parks and Recreation Building. Visitors to City buildings will be required to answer the COVID-19 Self-Check Screening Questions and have their temperature taken. Interior offices within City Hall, Parks and Recreation are still closed to the public, and other City buildings (such as the Police and Fire Departments) are also closed to visitors.
