NDOT Seeks Comments on Henderson Interchange



The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) is seeking input on the I-11/I-215/I-515 Interchange (the Henderson Interchange near Fiesta Casino, at I-11 and Lake Mead Parkway). The State wants to:

- Resolve existing roadway deficiencies in the Henderson Interchange and surrounding roadways;
- Provide transportation improvements to serve existing and future growth areas;
- Restore local traffic connectivity;
- Accommodate regional and local plans.

NDOT plans a public meeting on July 22, 2021 from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Henderson Lifeguard Arena, 222 South Water Street, Henderson, in the Center Ice Room. A formal presentation will take place in the same location at 5:30 p.m.
