Congratulations to BC Fire, Recipient of \$148,000 FEMA Grant



The Boulder City Fire Department was awarded FEMA's Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) for self-contained breathing apparatus (air packs). The total award amount is \$147,952.00. The grant was created in 2001 to meet firefighting and emergency response needs of fire departments and non-affiliated emergency medical service organizations across the country. The city is

responsible for covering \$14,752.00 in costs, and had allocated \$168,000 for the project in the Capital Improvement Plan Budget. Rep. Susie Lee advocated for the funding. Deputy Chief Greg Chesser applied for the grant on behalf of the department. "The Boulder City Fire Department is very grateful for the FEMA Assistance to Firefighter Grant to fund the purchase of our new self-contained breathing apparatus," said Fire Chief Will Gray. "This new, state of the art equipment will provide a safer work environment for our firefighters and allow great accountability on the fireground."
