For the second consecutive year, the City of Boulder City received the Government Finance Officers Association's (GFOA) Distinguished Budget Presentation Award. The recognition is for the FY2022 (July 1, 2021-June 30, 2022) budget. The award reflects the commitment of the Finance Department staff to meet the highest principles of governmental budgeting. There are over 1,700 participants in the Budget Awards Program. Award criteria requires meeting nationally recognized guidelines for effective budget presentation and measure how well an entity's budget serves as a policy document, financial plan, operations guide, and communications device.
